The words "getting lucky" will have a whole new meaning for many Miami residents next weekend as they bid over one-of-kind pieces of art work

created by local artists.

The Bakehouse Art Complex will be hosting their fourth-annual "Lucky You!" Art Raffle fundraiser this Friday, November 11, at 561 N.W. 32 St. in Wynwood, to help fund the free art exhibitions and wine tastings they provide the Miami art scene with every year.

Including over 70 original works of art from various Bakehouse artists, the event will be hosted by NBC Miami reporter Roxanne Vargas and will take place from 7 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.

Singer Angela Laino will be preforming live at the event, and DJ V and DJ Immortal will spin on the turn tables for the remainder of the party. Cocktails from Bacardi Sapphire and a wine bar will also be available as the BAC celebrates its 25th anniversary.

"[This raffle] is special to us; we're making this year as big as possible," said Lauren Wagner, the BAC's director of exhibitions.

The BAC always holds their raffle on the second Friday of November, and since the date just so happens to be 11/11/11, the theme for this years' event is "Wishful Thinking." At 11:11 p.m. there will be a large raffle on an undisclosed, surprise piece of art.

A single ticket for the event costs \$45 online, and will be \$55 at the door. However, large groups can purchase tickets in packages of 13 for only \$120.00. All proceeds from the event will go to benefit the BAC's free art exhibitions throughout the year.

Tickets include all of the "Lucky You!" festivities, as well as admission to The Stage's First Anniversary Bash on that evening, which begins at 11:30 p.m. and will include live painting, music, and a food truck rally, for those who want to keep the night going.

"We are fortunate enough to get both the older art collecting crowd, and the younger art enthusiast crowd. We don't get the [typical crowd]," Wagner said.


