

The North Miami Avenue exit on I-195 eastbound will reopen temporarily during Art Basel and the Wynwood Art Fair, according to Monica Diaz,

Florida Department of Transportation information specialist.

The exit will be open from Oct. 21 to Oct. 23, from 6 a.m. to 12 a.m. for the Wynwood Art Fair, and from Nov. 29 to Dec. 4 during the same hours for Art Basel, Diaz said via email.

FDOT and the contractors working on the project, Condotte America Inc., have been considering reopening the ramp for the events since at least August, and have recently confirmed the dates for the openings.

Diaz said the decision was made based off of the many concerns locals had about the negative impact the closure of the ramp would have on these two events.

"By reopening the ramp, it is anticipated that the community will execute these events successfully and that visitors will be encouraged to come, invest and generate more income to the local businesses," she said.


