The American Cancer Society is hosting a 5K walk at the Shops at Midtown Miami on Oct. 9 to raise funds for breast cancer research and to provide services to those affected by the disease.

Among the walkers will be breast-cancer survivor Bibiana Salmon, who ended her cancer treatment last year, after four months of chemotherapy and six weeks of heat-wave inducing radiation.

Salmon's mother was also diagnosed with breast cancer, as well as her husband, father, and grandfather who were lost to cancer.

With her pink bra already decked-out, Salmon said she's excited for the 5K, which she will walk with her daughters Camille and Tabitha.

"There is hope," Salmon said. "The cure is out there; it's a matter of time, and it's our responsibility to make sure we advance [the search for] it."


